Plebiscite

Chapter 16

1. The approval of the ratepayers of the Town of Kentville required under the provisions of the Municipal Affairs Act and under the provisions of the Towns' Incorporation Act, shall be sought by a plebiscite, whenever the subject matter requiring such approval is the borrowing and/or expenditure of a sum of money exceeding Fifty Thousand Dollars.
2. Voting at plebiscites shall be by ballot only, and the Town Clerk shall cause a sufficient number of ballot papers to be printed, setting out the question or questions respecting which the voting is to be taken.
3. The voting at plebiscites shall be taken between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on the day fixed by the Town Council; said times to be Atlantic Standard Time or Atlantic Daylight Saving Time, in accordance with the system of time then in effect at the Town Office of the Town of Kentville.
4. The procedure at the taking of the vote at plebiscites, and the counting of the ballots after a vote has been taken, shall be as nearly as possible the same, as in the case of elections for a Mayor or Councillors of the Town.
