

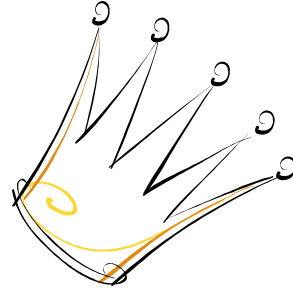

Once accepted as a candidate, participants will follow the guidelines and requirements as listed below.

- 1. Participants will submit an up to date resume to the Parks and Recreation Department by April 19th 2010. The resume will be shared with the judging panel and be used to create a biography that will be read by the MC at the Princess Tea.**
- 2. Each Junior Princess Candidate and a guardian will attend the Princess Tea on April 29th 2010. Arrival for participants will be at 6:00pm for the interview portion of the evening. Junior Princesses should be dropped off by a parent at the fire hall for 6:00pm. Parents will be admitted when the doors open at 6:45 pm. Participants will be interviewed as part of a group.**
- 3. Junior Princess Candidates will prepare a 2 minute speech on a topic selected from the list below. Each participant will deliver their speech during the Tea. Cue cards may be used for delivery.**
- 4. Each participant will have a reserved seat at a special table for the Junior Princess Candidates. Each Junior Princess will be provided with one complimentary ticket to the Tea which may be given to a parent or guardian. Parents who wish to buy additional tickets may do so at the door.**
