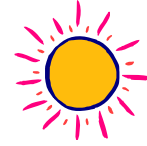


# Kentville Tennis 2011 – Parent Information

## **DATES:**

Session 1: July 4<sup>th</sup> – July 15<sup>th</sup>

Session 2: July 18<sup>th</sup> – July 29<sup>th</sup>

Session 3: August 1<sup>st</sup> – August 12<sup>th</sup>

Session 4: August 15<sup>th</sup> – August 26<sup>th</sup>

Our tennis programs run for two week sessions, Monday to Friday mornings, 50 minute lessons each day.

**BEGINNER:** 9:00am – 9:50am

**INTERMEDIATE:** 10:00am – 10:50am

**ADVANCED:** 11:00am – 11:50am

Depending on the number of participants lesson times may vary. Be sure to check with the Tennis Director Dakota Hopper each session to ensure what time your child is expected to arrive. Also keep in mind it is a good idea to show up 5 to 10 minutes before lessons to make sure that they are ready to go!

## **THINGS TO BRING TO LESSONS:**

- Proper footwear (sneakers are preferred)
- Lots of water!
- Sunscreen (Apply before coming to lessons)
- Clothing suitable for being active
- Your own tennis racquet, or borrow one of ours!
- Your own tennis balls, or borrow ours!
- A Smile ☺

## **STRIKE POLICY:**

To ensure everyone has fun at the tennis courts this summer, our staff will be enforcing a “3 strikes you’re out” discipline protocol this summer. As such, parents are asked to please discuss appropriate behavior with their children prior to their participation in this program. The first time a child must be disciplined they will receive their first strike (strike 1). Following this first strike the parent will be notified at pick up on the day of the incident. Strike 2 will result when a child has to be spoken to for a second time, parents will be notified with a phone call home after the incident. If a child receives a 3<sup>rd</sup> strike, they will be removed from the program for the remainder of that day, as well as the rest of the session. Depending on the severity of the incident, the child may or may not be permitted to attend future sessions for which they have registered. In order to make tennis lessons an enjoyable place for all who participate, we ask that you please go over this policy with your children to avoid potential problems.
